

## B400 Senior Integration Seminar

### BOOKS AND SUMMARIES ASSIGNMENT

- No textbooks are required for this course. Instead, students will read four books as described below.

You will be reading four books for this course and writing summary papers with the due dates noted below. You must select the first book from Group #1, the second from Group #2, the third from Group #3, the fourth from any group. You cannot reread a book you have already read. You will also be writing a 2 page single-spaced paper briefly summarizing the book, analyzing its strengths and weaknesses, plus the three most important things you learned from the book. You cannot turn in the paper unless you have completely read the book. Each book plus paper will count for 50 points; so the total of four books will be 200 points.

The following are the due dates for your books and summaries:

2. Group #2: Last day of Module 4 before midnight Sunday
3. Group #3: Last day of Module 6 before midnight Sunday
4. Any Group: Last day of Module 8 before midnight Sunday
