TMU Graduation Requirements (from the Academic Catalog):

The Master's University grants bachelor's degrees (i.e. Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Music, and Bachelor of Science) to students who satisfy the graduation requirements described below.

1. Complete a minimum of 122 semester units of credit.
2. Complete a minimum of 40 semester units in upper division courses.
3. Satisfy all General Education requirements.
4. Complete the required curriculum for the chosen major field(s) of study.
5. Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.00 (cumulative) in all TMU courses. (Some majors have different GPA requirements. Please see your department for details.)
6. Complete a minimum of 32 semester units of non-Directed Studies coursework at TMU or 32 semester units of TMU Online major courses.
7. Complete at least 12 of the final 24 semester units at TMU.

All students must be aware that they undertake complete responsibility for managing their progress toward graduation. Faculty advisors will attempt to assist in this process; however, given the fluidity of student progress, each student must ultimately assume responsibility for completing all graduation requirements. This checklist is designed as an aid to help students manage their progress, but it does NOT replace the Academic Catalog. In any case where this checklist contradicts the catalog, the catalog issued during the student's first semester at TMU shall be considered the official degree criteria criteria

LIBERAL STUDIES/GENERAL EMPHASIS:

84 major units, including minimum of 24 upper division, distributed among the four Liberal Studies subject areas as follows. *G.E. required courses are counted toward the unit requirement for the appropriate category. In each category, the student must complete at least 15 units and may count no more than 30 units toward the 84-unit requirement.*

English/Communication (15-30 units), including the following G.E. courses. Select additional courses from English (E prefix, such as literature surveys [e.g. American, English, World literature], genres [e.g. poetry, drama], or authors [e.g. Shakespeare, Austen]) and Communication (C prefix, such as speech, writing, or other communication areas). *Some major-specific courses also count (e.g. MGT330 Business Communications).*
