While living in residence at TMU during the summer break, you are responsible to adhere to the following TMU and Residence Hall policies:

PAYMENT

- Payment for summer housing must be paid online at registration prior to your arrival.
- Payment for housing is required any time your possessions are in TMU Residence. No exceptions will be made.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

- Check-in is available on the following days for the DMin program:
 - o Wednesday, July 6, 2026, from 9:00am to 5:00pm for 1st & 4th year students starting with orientation on 7/6.
 - o Wednesday, July 7, 2026, from 9:00am-5:00pm for the remaining students.
- Upon arrival at TMU, you will be issued your room key and assignment.
- While on campus, we will also ask you to sign the Assumption of Risk and Release of Liability Form.
- Check-Out: You will be given a self-checkout form, which will allow you to check out at any time after the program ends. We ask that all students be out of dorms by Saturday, July 18th at 5pm. Failure to complete the self-checkout process will result in a \$100 fine.

HOUSING & ACCOMODATIONS

- You will be staying in Waldock Hall, and will be given your room assignment at check-in.
- You are responsible for the general cleanliness and maintenance of your room, including common areas.
- You will be provided with the following accommodations:
 - o Twin Mattress
 - o Closet (no hangers provided)
 - o Bathroom + Showers
 - o Microwave (in the hallway)
 - o Washer/Dryer Rooms (You will need to download an app using the QR code on the washer to pay for each load)
 - o Desk and Chair
 - o Drawer Space
 - o 1 AC Unit per Room
 - o Drinking Fountain
- We recommend packing the following items:
 - o Bedding for an XL Twin Bed
 - o Pillow
 - o Towel

- Toiletries
- Shower Sandals
- Food/Snacks
- Refillable Water Bottle
- You will need to provide your own food and snacks. The dorm does not have a refrigerator. There is a microwave for your convenience. We do have a wonderful coffee shop on campus, Trophy Coffee, open 8-4pm, Monday through Saturday. We highly recommend Fiesta Taco, which is located in the canyon within walking distance. Main Street in Newhall also has plenty of dining options, about a mile away. On Saturday morning, the Newhall Farmer's Market is just a ten-minute walk away!

WIFI INSTRUCTIONS

- You may use the "TMU Guest" Wi-Fi while you are on campus, which is accessible anywhere on campus.
- There is no password required. "TMU Guest" will allow you 4 hours of access to Wi-Fi. At the end of 4 hours, re-login to your computer to refresh the Wi-Fi access.

- Please note that the TMU campus is about a 20-minute freeway drive from the seminary/Grace Community Church campus. Please arrange transportation accommodations accordingly.
